Apache Language Grant Mentors (3-Positions)

Primary Functions: The goal of the grant program is to preserve and revitalize the Mescalero Apache Language.

Responsibilities:

- Has the responsibility to fully understand and implement the policies and procedures of the Mescalero Apache School.
- Is a highly proficient, fluent speaker of the Mescalero Apache Language
- Does not need to have experience teaching the Mescalero Apache Language in a formal setting.
- Understands or is willing to learn about the language-learning process.
- Is willing to spend 4 hours a day with apprentices speaking only the Mescalero Apache Language.
- Is willing to commit at least two years to this project.
- Is willing to overcome any fears, inhibitions, or negative feelings about speaking and sharing the Mescalero Apache Language.
- Is willing to learn and to use different techniques to pass on the Mescalero Apache Language.
- Is willing to be audio and video recorded
- Required to keep journal's about program activities
- Is willing to work at the Mescalero Apache School and obtain all necessary approvals and licenses. (Based on First People's Cultural Council, B.C's Mentor-Apprentice Language Program Handbook, 2012)
- Performs other duties as may be assigned by the supervisor.

Key Relationships:

- Position reports to the Cultural Director.
- Interacts with school staff members, students, community groups and school administration when required.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Minimum of a High School Diploma or GED required.
- Must have reliable transportation.
- Must be punctual.
- Must be able to follow all school policies and procedures
- Within the scope of Indian preference, all candidates will receive consideration without regard to race, color, sex, national origin or other non-merit factors

Term of Employment:

- Determined by grant.
- Salary as determined by grant.

Working Conditions:

- Work is accomplished within a school environment
- Will require long periods of standing.
- From time to time, will require longer than normal work days due to demands of the program.

Applications will be accepted until the close of business on Thursday, September 8, 2022.

- ***ALL positions require federal, state, local and sex offender background checks and clearance from any criminal charges prior to employment.***
- ***ALL positions require initial drug testing upon hire, then random monthly drug testing.***
- ***Selection for employment will be based on the Mescalero Apache Tribal Ordinance 06-02.***
